* There were six fire events during the month of December. The building fire in Slater-Marietta requested a Brush Truck response only and the Carbon Monoxide Alarm response was non-emergent.

Glassy Mountain provided 19 Mutual Aid responses in December. One was for a Building Fire (Slater-Marietta). Two were service calls (Trees down). Three were Good Intent calls (Dispatched and cancelled enroute). The remaining 13 were medical responses as a GCEMS QRV. Two of those were cancelled enroute to the alarm.

Glassy Mountain provided a total of 162 Mutual Aid responses in 2018. Of those, 24 were fire-related (Building Fire, Outside Fire, Fire Alarm, Trees or Power Lines down, Lost or Missing persons, or Motor Vehicle Accidents); 37 were dispatched and then cancelled enroute; the remaining 101 were /QRV responses at the request of Greenville County EMS.
