* There was one structure fire in the district in March. Additionally, there were 7 personnel, from Landrum Fire Rescue and 1 from Gowensville Fire Department for a total of 16 personnel on scene.

Glassy Mountain provided 27 Mutual Aid responses in March. One was for an Outside Fire, one was for a transfer of a patient from a remote area, and two were for Automatic Fire Alarms. The remaining 23 were medical responses as a GCEMS QRV. Eleven of those were cancelled enroute to the alarm.

2. Personnel:

- Hired on new full time firefighter to replace the employee that changed to part time status.
- Brought on 4 new volunteers. Two have EMT training and two are currently enrolled in EMT at Blue Ridge Technical College



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3. Meetings / Operational Initiatives:

- Attended the Greenville County Fire Chiefs' Association monthly meeting.
- Attended two special meetings of the GCFCA on Grant Radio Distribution.
- Assisted with a CPR class for department personnel.
- Attended at Hands-on Extrication training event with Green River (NC) Fire Rescue.
- Provided EMT Continuing Education training for department personnel.
- Met with GCEMS on new Ambulance Deployment strategies and changes to fire department responses in Greenville County.
- The average Turnout time was 00:55. Full report of turnout time per apparatus is attached.

4. Inspections / Re-Inspections / Preplans and Plan Reviews:

- Four inspections and one Building Plan review were completed in March.
