\* There was one structure fire in the district in April. Additionally, there were 5 personnel from Landrum Fire Rescue and 2 from Gowensville Fire Department for a total of 18 personnel available.

Glassy Mountain provided 15 Mutual Aid responses in April. One was for an Outside Fire, five were for Motor Vehicle Accidents, and two were for Automatic Fire Alarms. The remaining 7 were medical responses as a GCEMS QRV. Three of those were cancelled enroute to the alarm.
