The location does not have hydrant service, so we will be conducting water shuttle during the event. Full Time Personnel are required to attend the event, unless excused by Chief Staples. If you are available to help with this event, please let me know ASAP, so I can add you to the Incident Action Plan (IAP) and make assignments.

This will be a great training event, we will see fire behavior and fire containment operations, not to mention pump operations and water shuttle training. We have invited our neighbor Departments to join us, so we should have some joint training also. Please try your best to attend, we don't get these types of opportunities very often.
