* This includes 2 structure fires but does not include the rekindle of the Pierce Road fire. Both structure fires also had personnel from Landrum and Gowensville fire departments (Pierce Road) and Slater-Marietta and Tigerville fire departments (Highway 25) in addition to Glassy personnel in the number above.

Glassy Mountain provided 5 Automatic or Mutual Aid responses in June. Two were for medical calls in the Slater-Marietta and Lake Cunningham areas. Two were for motor vehicle incidents (fire and motor vehicle crash) in the River Falls area. The remaining incident was a fire alarm sounding at a commercial property in Tigerville's area.

2. Personnel:

- Received four volunteer applications. A new firefighter/EMT was hired to replace Connor Christie who served his last tour on July 31.

- Provided EMT continuing education to department and neighboring agency EMTs.
