* Both structure fire responses were out of the district. One was in Gowensville and the other in Tigerville. We had one reported structure fire which ended up being an overheated motor in an appliance.

Glassy Mountain provided 10 Mutual Aid responses in September. Two were for a Structure Fires, 3 were for Motor Vehicle Accidents, 2 were EMS QRV responses that were cancelled en route, 1 was a QRV response and treatment in Gowensville's area, 1 was to assist other agencies (GCEMS and Lake Cunningham FD) with removal of a victim from a wooded area, and the remaining alarm was for a fire alarm in Tigerville.

2. Personnel:

- We added a full-time member to replace an employee that resigned in August and hired one part time paramedic. We also added one volunteer to the roster in September.
